**Noaa Weather Portland** - NOAA National Weather Service Portland, OR. Multi-Day Severe Weather and Heavy Rain Event Starts Wednesday. A storm tracking through the West will eject out into the central/southern Plains tomorrow and be the primary feature to ignite a multi-day severe weather and heavy rain event. Major Severe Thunderstorm Outbreak Expected Across Parts of the South on Saturday. The weather focus will shift south through tomorrow, as a strong area of low pressure develops across the southern Plains and moves northeastward across the Mississippi Valley. Rain showers. Cloudy, with a high near 56. Southwest wind 6 to 10 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New rainfall amounts between a quarter and half of an inch possible. In addition to the steady snow that many saw yesterday, we also had a number of daily record low maximum temperatures set. Or in other words, record coldest high temperature for the day.
